#### 授業の目標 (Course Objectives)

The course is designed to introduce theoretical concepts and basic knowledge on international cooperation, both at the state and the society levels, with special reference to and emphasis on Myanmar as we plan to conduct a field trip to the country.

#### 授業の内容 (Course Contents)

Students participate in a field trip to Myanmar for 10 days (August 18-28).

In addition to the field trip, there are Pre-field work lectures and Post-field work lectures held from April to November. These classes will be held at Rikkyo University Ikebukuro campus and Meiji University Surugadai campus. Students are required to attend all parts of the course.

Pre Field Work Lectures and Seminars (April to August)

The lectures and seminars on theoretical portion of the course and basic knowledge on Myanmar will be conducted before the field trip.

Field Trip (Aug. 18-Aug. 28)

We will stay mostly in Yangon. A field trip to Myanmar will be organized after the first part of the lectures/seminars series. The objective of the field trip is to help students understand factors that influence the international or regional cooperation behavior of Myanmar, at both state and societal levels, through the visits of historical sites, museums, academic institutions, NGO activities and local communities.

Post Field Work Lectures and Seminars (September to November)

After the fieldtrip, the second portion of lectures and seminars will continue with a special focus on Myanmar's foreign relations and cooperation with extra-regional countries.
